Dear President Tetlow:

I am writing regarding the ongoing negotiations towards a new contract between the union of Fordham University's non-tenure track faculty, represented by SEIU Local 200United, and the university administration.

I understand that the union and university administration have been negotiating towards a contract since March, 2022 and that despite more than 20 bargaining sessions, the current contract extension expired on November 2. I appreciate that these negotiations are complex, but I am concerned by reports that the administration's latest proposal for compensation for non-tenure track full-time and part-time faculty does not take into account the impact of the cost of living in the New York City area.

As Chair of the New York State Senate Education Committee, I believe that Fordham University's mission to provide a student-centered education based on close collaboration among students and faculty can best be fulfilled when members of the faculty are compensated fairly and free of other concerns. Therefore, I urge you to bargain in good faith and work promptly towards an agreement that is beneficial for all concerned.
